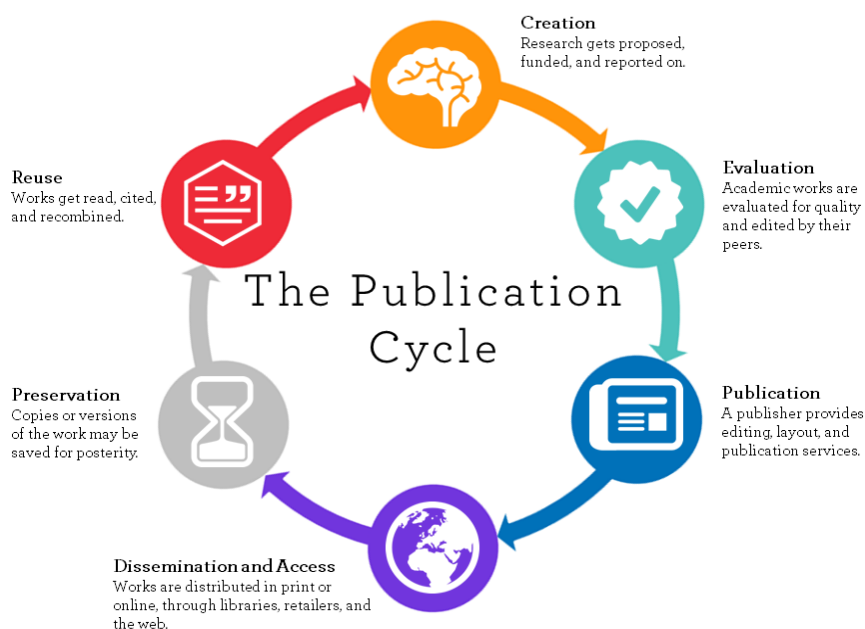


University of Namibia Library Scholarly Communications Services

- Guide with selection of accredited journals for publishing research papers in Open Access and Hybrid, and commercial journals to avoid predatory publishing
- guide with ORCID registration

- Copyright
- Research Africa Funding
